ADMISSIONS POLICY

Thank you for your interest in St. Stanislaus School. We believe that St. Stanislaus School provides a quality Catholic education and a safe environment for all of our students. As a Franciscan community we try our best to accommodate the needs of all students. Program offerings include art, music, computer, and physical education for all grade levels.

St. Stanislaus School welcomes tours throughout the school year for interested families. Tours can be arranged by calling the school office or using the contact form available on the school's website. Enrollment for the following school year begin at the end of January.

Students are selected for admission to the school on the basis of academic potential and developmental readiness for the school's programs. When appropriate, testing is used as a tool to provide information to assist in the assessment of each candidate. In all cases, the school retains the right to determine whether or not to select a student for admission.

Typically those decisions are based upon multiple criteria:

- academic readiness or qualification
- ability of the school to meet the child's academic, social and emotional needs
- developmental readiness (particularly in the preschool programs)
- appropriateness of the match between the family and the school mission.

All new students are monitored for the first marking term for both academics and attendance. At the end of the first term the student's academic and overall progress is assessed to determine that they can succeed at St. Stanislaus School.

Students enrolling at St. Stanislaus School must complete an application process which includes providing the school with their child's birth certificate, medical records and immunizations, and baptismal certificate, when applicable. All families must pay the annual registration fee. Students entering grades 1 through 8 must provide the school with the student's prior academic records. Any students with educational plans or accommodations must provide copies of those plans to the school prior to admissions.

All students entering grades 1 through 8 are asked to shadow in the class they will be entering for a day in order to get a sense of the school's mission and expectation. Kindergarten students and parents attend an orientation each June in order to see the school, get acclimated with our policies, and complete entrance testing. Preschool students and parents attend an orientation in August.

St. Stanislaus School does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sex, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, age or disability in admission to, access to, employment in, or treatment in its programs and activities. All students are welcome to apply for admission.
