Failure to follow proper dress code will result in a uniform slip, which must be signed by a parent.

GIRL'S UNIFORM

Primary & Intermediate

Required:

- White blouse with short or long sleeves
- Knee length wine/grey plaid jumper
- Wine, grey or white knee socks, ankle socks or tights
- Comfortable, flat, full-backed dress shoes are to be worn

Optional:

- Uniform wine cardigan sweater or school sweatshirt
- Grey uniform slacks with a belt may be worn from November 1st through March 31st

Junior High

Required:

- White oxford blouse with short or long sleeves
- Knee length wine/grey plaid uniform skirt
- Wine colored uniform vest or pullover v-neck sweater
- Wine, grey or white knee socks, ankle socks or tights
- Comfortable, flat, full-backed dress shoes are to be worn

Optional:

- Uniform wine pullover sweater or school sweatshirt
- Grey uniform slacks with a belt may be worn from November 1st through March 31st

No knit or polo shirts can be worn and top button of blouse must always be buttoned. Quarter length sport socks are not permitted and wearing them will result in an out of uniform slip. Sandals, clogs, sneakers and boots are not to be worn in school.

Makeup, tattoos, excessive or inappropriate jewelry, nail polish, fake nails, or French manicures are not permitted. Only stud earrings may be worn. Large or dangling earrings are not permitted. Students wearing inappropriate jewelry will be asked to remove it.

BOY'S UNIFORM

Primary

Required:

- Wine colored polo shirt with short or long sleeves
- Grey uniform slacks with belt
- Black, grey or white socks
- Black, brown or grey dress shoes

Optional

- Uniform wine cardigan sweater or school sweatshirt

Intermediate & Junior High

Required:

- White oxford shirt with short or long sleeves
- Plaid School Tie for Intermediate. Solid Wine School Tie for Junior High.
- Grey uniform slacks with belt
- Black, grey or white socks
- Black, brown or grey dress shoes

Optional

- Uniform wine cardigan sweater or school sweatshirt

Shirt sleeves are not to be rolled up and the top button on the shirt must always be buttoned. Slacks must be purchased from the uniform company. Quarter length sport socks are not permitted and wearing them will result in an out of uniform slip. Sneakers should only be worn only on gym days for intermediate students. Jogging shoes and boots are not to be worn in school. Earrings, tattoos and excessive or inappropriate jewelry are not permitted.

GYM UNIFORM

Required:

- Gym Shirt with school logo
- Maroon or grey sweatpants or warm-ups with school logo
- Sneakers with laces that are tied

Optional:

- Solid maroon shorts with logo may be worn during gym class only

PRIMARY STUDENTS: Wear the school gym shirt and solid grey sweatpants to school on their gym day. Girls may wear the gym shirt with maroon or grey shorts under their jumpers. Shorts **may not** be worn unless under sweatpants or a jumper.

INTERMEDIATE STUDENTS: May wear their sneakers to school on gym day but must change into their gym uniform.

JUNIOR HIGH STUDENTS: Wear the regular school uniform on gym day. They must change into their sneakers and gym uniform.

Students in grades 6, 7 and 8 need to bring deodorant. No hair care products or aerosol deodorants are allowed.

All students are to take gym classes unless excused by a note from their physician. Students who come unprepared for gym class will not be allowed to participate and will receive a lower grade.

OUT OF UNIFORM DAYS

Throughout the year students may have out of uniform days.

Students May Wear: casual slacks, jeans, sweatpants, sweat and T-shirts (shirts with inappropriate, unacceptable or offensive sayings are not allowed), sport shirts, jerseys with sleeves and sneakers. **Socks must always be worn.**

Students May Not Wear: tank tops, sleeveless tops, leggings, short skirts, shirts with inappropriate sayings or pictures, sandals, clogs, makeup, fingernail polish or excessive jewelry.

Shorts and capris are not permitted unless the Administration has given special permission. When shorts are permitted they should be Bermuda or walking shorts no more than 4 inches above the knee. No low rise jeans or tops that show midriff skin are permitted.

Students who are inappropriately dressed will have to call home/parents and have their uniforms brought to school.
Good Rule: If you think you shouldn't wear it, you shouldn't.

ALL UNIFORM REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES ARE SUBJECT TO THE DISCRETION OF THE ADMINISTRATION. Students who repeatedly violate the uniform policy, will be denied participation in the next out-of-uniform day or will serve a detention.
