

ST. STANISLAUS SCHOOL FAMILY SERVICE COMMITMENT 2021-2022

This booklet has been developed by the Administration. For families new to the school, it is an opportunity to acquaint you with the many activities taking place throughout the school year. For returning families, we hope that it will help you select those activities you would like to participate in this year.

The Family Service Commitment Program is familiar to many parochial school parents across the country. We initiated the program at St. Stanislaus School in 1996. The enthusiasm and cooperation of so many families has ensured the success of all scheduled events.

It is often said that the difference between a good school and a great school is the parents. We know that we all share in wanting the best possible educational experience for our children. Through your involvement you help to make St. Stanislaus School a truly great school.

During the 2021 - 2022 school year, each family is required to fulfill ten (10) hours of service. Service hours can be performed by grandparents, but cannot be transferred to other families. You are not limited to 10 hours. We enjoy your company!

Families may opt for a \$250.00 payment (\$25.00 per hour) in lieu of the required hours. Families of Kindergarten and 8th grade students must complete their hours by May 26, 2021 or pay the monetary equivalent prior to graduation. Families who have not served their 10 hours by May 26, 2022 will be responsible for contributing the monetary equivalent.

Service hour documentation sheets will be needed for families to receive credit. Families should fill out the form completely and have it authorized by the event/committee chairperson. The completed and signed form should then be returned to the school office to credit your hours. Please keep a copy for your records should any questions arise. **Volunteers are responsible for providing signed documentation to**

receive proper credit. This applies particularly for athletic coaches.

The administration reserves the right to use its discretion in determining the placement of individuals in service areas, in approving additional events, or initiating changes to the service commitment.

Note: ***Due to the fact that field trip chaperoning opportunities are very limited, field trip chaperoning <u>"WILL NOT"</u> be used toward fulfilling your service commitment hours.***

Individuals serving in any on-going school or parish positions (listed below) automatically fulfill their service commitment. Please have the service form filled out, authorized, and returned to the school office.

The faculty and staff look forward to working with you to promote the value of service as you join in the teaching ministry of the Church. We encourage you to ask for help, direction, or advice as you participate in the numerous opportunities to volunteer.

Together let us pray that God, who began this good work in us, may carry it through to completion. We thank you for your priceless gift of gratuitous service.

HASA Bake Sale & Raffle – Saturday, TBD Sunday, TBD



Descriptions

<u>Teacher Aide</u> – An individual to assist the teacher in the classroom one day a week. <u>Computer Aide -</u> Volunteer to assist computer teacher with Kindergarten and Grade 1 classes weekly.

<u>Pre-school Volunteer Aide</u> – An individual to assist in the supervision of small groups of children in the pre-school one day a week.

<u>Lunch Monitor</u> – An individual who helps to supervise students during the lunch, assist students with opening containers, and helping supervise students during recess period.

<u>Library Aide</u> – An individual who helps in the library, cataloging books, helping children select books, and reading stories to small groups of children.

<u>Parent Safety Patrol</u> – Ongoing commitment to facilitate the safe flow of students from busses behind the school in the mornings.

<u>Developmental Office Aides</u> – Individuals who are willing to help at home or in school with projects such as bulk mailings, etc.

<u>Archives Organizer</u> – An individual who will organize photos and newspaper clippings.

<u>Raffle Prize Coordinator</u> – An individual who will collect contributions for a raffle at selected events.


